BERAKAS FOREST RESERVE CAMP SITE

Forest Recreation Park consists mainly of Kerangas Forest that had endured forest fires several times, resulting in a number of unique and interesting species of trees, such as the Ru Runang (Casuarina sp), Sindoksindok (Endospermumsp) and Selunsor (Tristania sp). Stands of trees such as Acacia mangium, Jagus, Klinki Pine and Kapur bukit can also be found.

An attractive feature of the Berakas Forest recreation Park is its location besides the sea.



It is 18 kilometres from the capital and has an area of forest reserve inclusive of the park about 348 hectares. As with other recreational parks, essential facilities are also catered for visitors. Berakas Forest Recreation Park is popular for its camping grounds and had been used by many.

KAMPONG AYER CULTURAL AND TOURISM GALLERY (KACTG)

Built with a style replicating a grand Kampong Ayer house and with a distinctive observation tower that gives visitors a bird's eye view of the water village and its surroundings, the KACTG has become the latest tourist attraction in Bandar Seri Begawan. There are galleries containing background information of the water village from its historical origins until its present day.



• THE ARTS GALLERY (GALERI SENI)

The Art Gallery is housed in the Old Custom Building by the Dermaga Diraja in Bandar Seri Begawan - a solid, windowless building that has been converted into the centre of the Brunei art scene. The venue faces the heritage site of Kampong Ayer and visitors get to hear and see the speed boats that bounces back and forth from the water village to the city. Inside the gallery, it is a simple set-up where wooden partitions are used to create 'rooms' within the rectangular space. Visitors are allowed to flow through the 'rooms' and appreciate the myriad of paintings in various media and 3 installations created specially for this exhibition. It is the



first time that a local exhibition has included a participative installation - entitled Creat'art'ive Tree - that allows the public to participate and leave their own artistic mark on the display. Another installation entitled 'Nasi Katok', features a sole human as part of the creation, introducing the concept of 'live' art that broadens, challenges and questions society's traditional view of art.

• iCENTRE BRUNEI DARUSSALAM (AN INITIATIVE BY BEDB)

The iCentre was established to develop entrepreneurship, technology and innovation based startups through an incubator program. Over the years, the iCentre along with strategic industry partners have created a technological and innovation ecosystem that supports the development of startup companies geared towards nation building.



JERUDONG SPORTS COMPLEX

Previously known as the Jerudong Shooting Range, the change of name to the Jerudong Sports Complex. In the long run, the new sports complex will be used as golf driving range, lawn bowling and a number of sports. The sports complex consist of 42.178 acres, of which 17.07 hectares are located in Kampong Jeerudong, Mukim Sengkurong.



TUTONG DISTRICT

TASEK MERIMBUN HERITAGE PARK

Located in Tutong District, about 1 hour 15 minutes drives from Bandar Seri Begawan. Administered by the Brunei Museum, the park aims to provide a safe haven for protected wildlife to breed, preserve flora and fauna, and to provide a base for scientific research and study. For those interested in botany or bird watching, there is also trail through the jungle. The park was declared as one of the ASEAN National Heritage Sites on November 29, 1984.



KIUDANG VILLAGE CONSULTATIVE COUNCIL (KVCC)

TUTONG'S Kampung Kiudang Village Consultative Council (MPK) has added a new honey product to its One Village, One Product (OVOP) initiative. Creator of Kampung Kiudang's award-winning herbal tea, Hj Amran Hj Johari, said the new product is named Madu Asli Q-Dang. "The product can be added to the wide range of 3MPK herbal teas we offer. It has a lot of nutritional value and can cure diseases (*As-Syifa*)."



TEMBURONG DISTRICT

ULU TEMBURONG NATIONAL PARK

This park is rich with unspoiled flora and fauna. It can be reached by a long boat or locally known as *Temuai*. At the park, you can enjoy strolling on the extensive wooden boardwalk and witness the fresh environment. Other excitements here are the Canopy Walk and the waterfall.



• OUTWARD BOUND BRUNEI DARUSSALAM (OBBD)

The historical milestone of Outward Bound Brunei Darussalam started back in 1992 by the wisdom and vision of His Majesty the Sultan of Brunei to initiate the idea of developing an Outward Bound Center for the youth of the country. With the financial help of the Brunei Shell Petroleum Company and Shell International and the Outward Bound "know how" of Winston Lim from Outward Bound Singapore, Outward Bound Brunei Darussalam began its operations by 1997. They now serve the citizens of Brunei with a variety of both residential and mobile courses from 3-14 days long. They work with local schools, colleges, universities and corporations to provide courses that encourage citizenship, responsibility and leadership.



AMO LONG HOUSE

Though the majority of Temburong's indignenous inhabitants have moved to detached homes, plenty still live in longhouses. In theory, unannounced visits are welcomed but some have formal arrangements with tour operators receiving guests.
